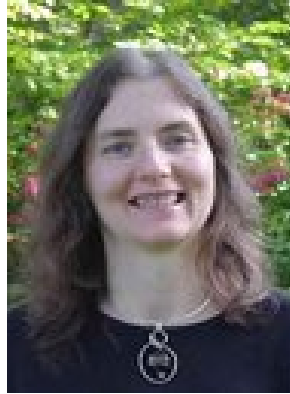


Women in the Early Hopedale Community
